 This indenture made this twentieth day of November
 in the year one thousand eight hundred & fifty one between
 Julia Griffiths of the City of Rochester County of Monroe
 State of New York of the first part & Frederick
 Douglass of the said City of Rochester of the second part Whereas the said
 Frederick Douglass by his indenture of Mortgage bearing
 date the 19th day of August 1850 did for the consideration of the
 Purposes therein mentioned convey to one Julia Griffiths by Mortgage
 duly assigned to the said Julia Griffiths certain lands in the City of
 Rochester County of Monroe State of New York of which the lands
 hereafter described are part & parcel And the said Frederick Douglass

on the day & date aforesaid has paid unto the said Julia Griffiths the sum
 of one hundred Dollars being part of the money secured by the Mortgage aforesaid
 as therein specified on which payment the said Julia Griffiths has agreed
 to release to the said Frederick Douglass his heirs & assigns the lands herein
 after described & to take & accept the residue of the said mortgaged
 premises as his security for the payment of moneys remaining unpaid
 on the said Mortgage Now therefore the said Julia Griffiths in consideration
 of the premises doth hereby grant & release assign & make over to the said
 Frederick Douglass & to his heirs & assigns all that part of the said
 mortgaged lands described as follows to wit commencing at a point
 on the West side of Alexander Street in the seventh ward in the City of
 Rochester one hundred & seventy two feet north of the Southern termination
 of land heretofore owned by James Brock & on the Northern boundary
 line of lot on Alexander Street heretofore owned by O. W. Bush and
 running from said point West on the Northern line of land heretofore
 owned to Nelson Postwick one hundred & twenty one feet thence north
 on a line parallel with Alexander Street forty feet thence East and
 parallel with the North boundary line of said Postwick land to
 Alexander Street thence South on Alexander Street to the place of
 beginning with the hereditaments & appurtenances thereunto belonging
 hereby released & conveyed to the said Frederick Douglass his heirs &
 assigns & to his heirs & assigns forever free & clear and
 discharged from & of the lien of the said mortgage & without
 whereby the said Julia Griffiths hath hereunto set his hand & seal
 the day & year first above written

This Indenture made the Twentieth day of November in the year one thousand Eight hundred fifty one between Julia Griffiths of the City of Rochester County of Monroe and State of New York of the first party and Frederick Douglass of the said City of Rochester of the second part Witnessed that Whereas the land Frederick Douglass by his Indenture of mortgage bearing date the 29th day of August AD 1849 did for the Consideration and for the purposes therein mentioned convey to one Eliza Griffiths by mortgage duly assigned to the Julia Griffiths Certain lands in the City of Rochester County of Monroe and State of New York and of which the lands herein after described are part and parcel and the said Frederick Douglass on the day and date aforesaid has paid unto the said Julia Griffiths the sum of one hundred Dollars being part of the money secured by the mortgage aforesaid as therein specified on which payment the said Julia Griffiths has agreed to release to the said Frederick Douglass his heirs and assigns the lands herein after described and to take and accept the residue of the said mortgaged premises as her security for the payment of monies remaining unpaid on the said mortgage ??? the therefore said Julia Griffiths in Consideration of the premises doth hereby grant and release assign and make over to the said Frederick Douglass and his heirs and assigning all that part of the said mortgaged lands described following ???? commencing at a point on the west side of Alexander Street in the seventh ward of the City of Rochester one hundred and seventy two feet north of the southern termination of lands heretofore owned by James Breck and on the Southern boundary line of lots on Alexander Street heretofore owned by O W Bush and running from said point west on the northerly line of land heretofore deeded to Nelson Bostwick one hundred and twenty one feet thence north on a line parallel with Alexander Street forty feet thence East and parallel with the north boundary line of said Bostwick land to Alexander Street thence South on Alexander Street to the place of beginning with the here ??????? ????????????? thereunto belonging (next line illegible) hereby released and conveyed to the aid Frederick Douglass his heirs and assigning and to his and their own proper use and ?????? forever free and clear discharged from and of the lien of the said mortgage ??? witness whereof the said Julia Griffiths hath hereunto set his sand and seal the day and year first above written.
