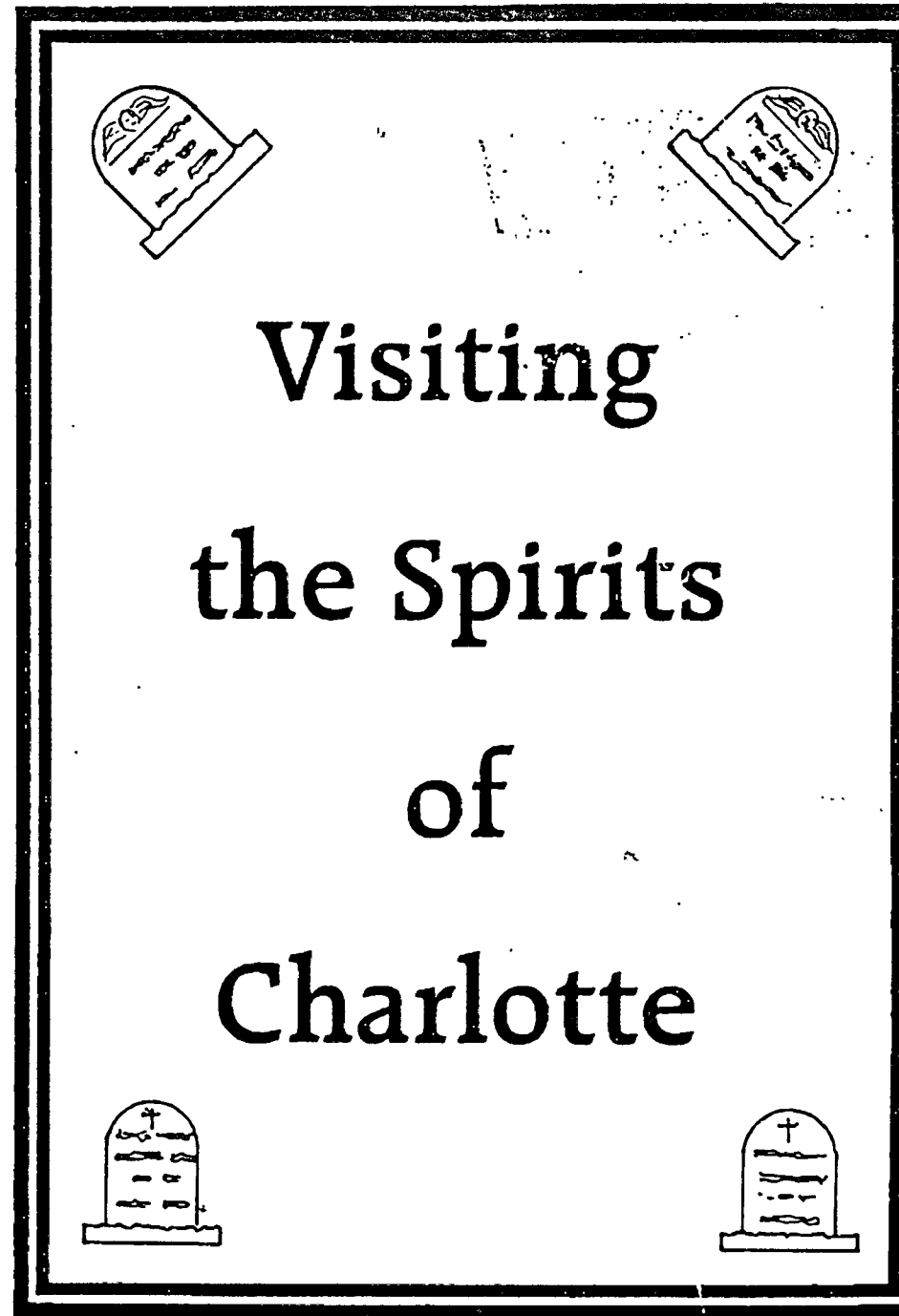


A Distinguished Dozen

First permanent white settlers.

4. Patch, Sam 1807 ~1829
Charlotte's folk hero.
5. Cook, Michael 1798 ~1846
Helped build the Lighthouse
Cuyler 1820 ~1853
Son of Michael. Drowned while L.H. Keeper.
6. Latta, Sam d.1827
Collector of Port and surveyor.
7. Pollard, Henry 1811 ~1887
Village blacksmith.
8. Latta, George 1795 ~1871
Entrepreneur and businessman.
9. Cook, Hiram 1842 ~1918
WWI Vet and Cuyler's son.
10. Stones ~ There are many.
Stoddard 1810 ~1892
Thought to be the first child born in what is now
Rochester.
11. Emerson, Amos d. March 19, 1840
First doctor in Charlotte.
12. Holden, Giles 1788 ~1867
2nd Lighthouse Keeper. 1823-1834.
Susan, 1797 ~1880 His wife.
Four children.
Mary d. 1862 at age 32. Wife of Giles, Jr.

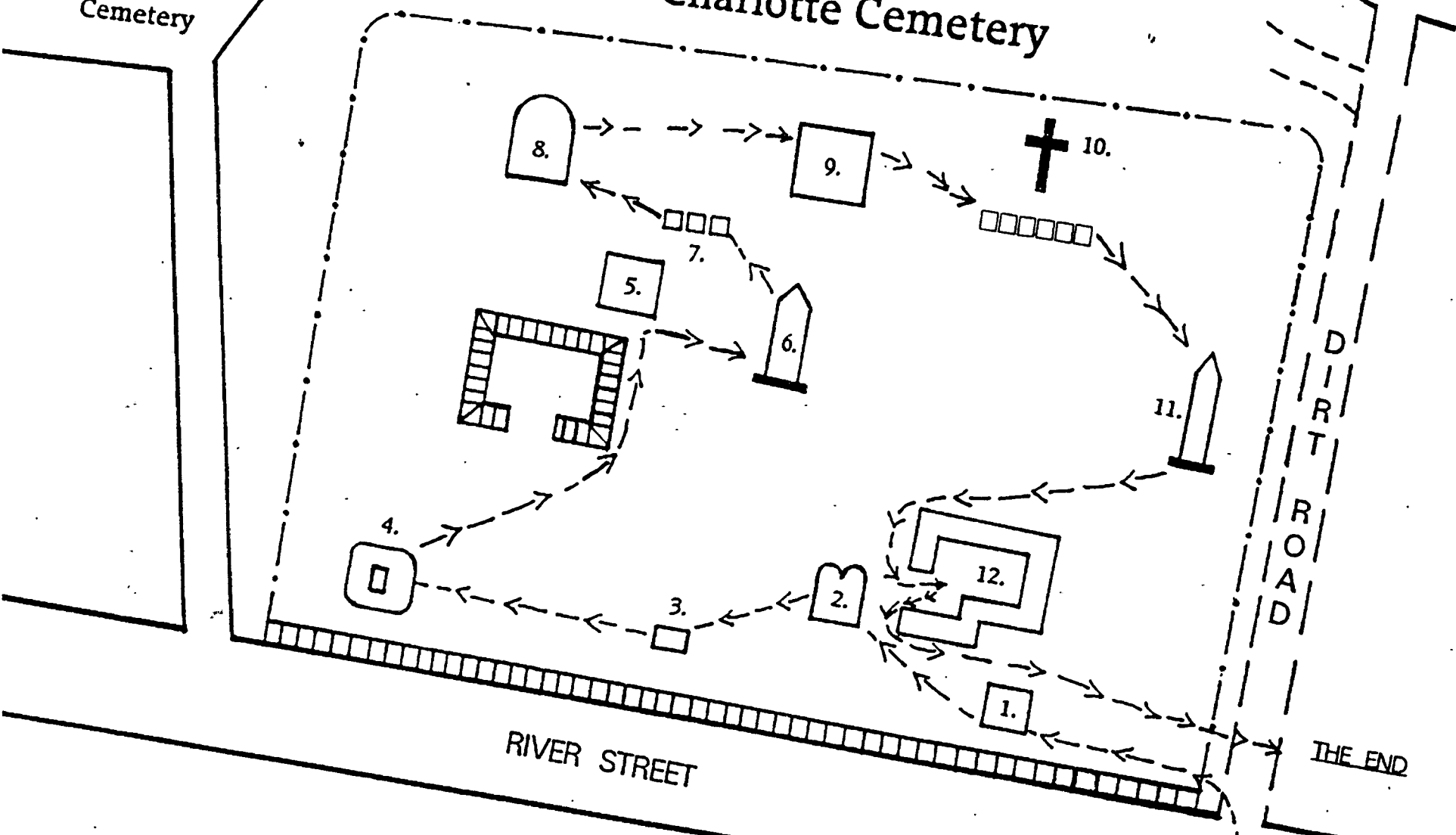
